Poster Presentations - Specifications and Guidelines for authors

1. A display board [36 inches (Vertical) by 24 inches (Horizontal) - 3 feet by 2 feet] is provided for each poster. All posters must be self-explanatory.
2. Display the reference number given by BMS at the top left corner of the final poster. Each poster should have a heading that includes the title, author(s) names and their affiliation(s), as provided in the accepted abstract.
3. The poster should include a clearly organised structure with introduction of the topic, objectives, methodology, results, discussion and conclusion. You are required to provide evidence by use of in-text and end-text citations. Each of these sections in the poster should be titled accordingly so that viewers can easily find them.
4. The poster information must be typewritten. The text should be of a size that can be easily read from a distance of about 1 to 1.5 m. Author should be able to decide on a suitable font size and required enlargement for graphics. If the presentation is not clear within the above distance, the poster would reflect the author's negligence. Please note that use of larger size fonts is very important.
5. Results are best conveyed using enlarged tables, figures, graphs, or photographs. A full explanatory title / figure legend is required of what is being presented under tables, figures, graphs, or photographs.
6. Posters should be printed and displayed by the oral presenter. A poster stand will be provided at the venue.
7. Failure to be present to explain your poster at the time allocated for poster presentation will be considered as non-presentation of the Abstract for the Research Symposium.
